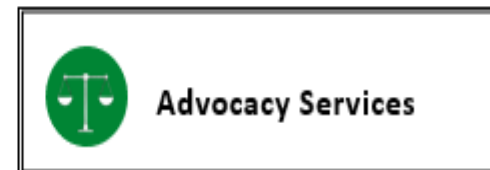


Native American Agriculture Fund
